



Robert Seeley Artistic Director

Robert T. Seeley, composer steps onto the stage again this holiday season, but this time as the Artistic Director of MODERN MEN, the Coachella Valley Men's Chorus.

For over 25 years, Robert T. Seeley has been writing music for the gay, lesbian, and feminist choral movement. In 1996, his ground-breaking choral and orchestral work. NakedMan, commissioned by the San Francisco Gay Men's Chorus, garnered national acclaim.

Its controversial text coupled with Seeley's extraordinary musical interpretation was unlike any choral music that had proceeded it. While six additional major works would follow in the ensuing years of his career, NakedMan would remain his signature piece. This work established his as one of the groundbreakers not only for the gay, lesbian, and feminist choral movement but also for the broader movement of contemporary choral music in an ever-shifting cultural paradigm.

Seeley, a longtime member of GALA, (the Gay and Lesbian Association of Choruses), has become one of the most recognized names on their roster of American Composers. His creative mastery and inimitable style have provided the largest cadre of compositions of any single composer. His music has been performed in some of the most highly esteemed concert and symphony venues in America, Canada, and Australia. From Carnegie Hall to The Kennedy Center, American vocalists who have sung the deeply moving passages of his music know instinctively and recognize almost immediately a "piece penned by his hand."

And that "hand" has never stopped. His signature is etched on some of the most widely sung choral works of the last two and a half decades: BraveSouls & Dreamers, Only Human, Songs of My Family, To A Dancing Star, Exile, and Metamorphosis. Along with some of the most glorious Christmas cantatas, these definitively set him apart from others before him and those who will follow.

On September 11, 2010, his musical excellence was recognized by the City of New York and onlookers from around the country when the Portland Gay Men's Chorus sang at the 10th anniversary commemoration of the 9/11 tragedy. Approved and designated as sacred music by the Archbishop of New York, BraveSouls & Dreamers was performed at St. John The Divine Cathedral.

There is much that could be said about Robert T. Seeley. The array of his accomplishments cross the broad spectrum of diverse artistry and professional excellence: Educator, administrator, vocalist, instrumentalist, theatrical director, jazz performer, composer, orchestrator, arranger, artistic director, and choral founder.

After serving as Artistic Director for the Palm Springs Gay Men's Chorus from 2011-2013, he is now thrilled to serve as the founder and Artistic Director of MODERN MEN, the Coachella Valley's first men's chorus.

Bruce Mangum Accompanist

Bruce Mangum, pianist, hails from Nampa, ID, and grew up in a musical family. He earned a Bachelor's degree in Applied Piano in 1992 from the College of Idaho in Caldwell, ID - 8 miles from his home. He completed one year toward a Master's in Piano Performance from the University of Idaho in Moscow, ID. Bruce began piano at age 7, and has studied with the late Dr. Fern Nolte Davidson, Dr. Jay Mauchley, Jeffrey Payne, Carol Rich, and most recently Tim Bruneau.



Bruce lived in Portland, OR, for 7 years where he accompanied local university music students and served as musical director for a number of community theatre productions. He won Musical Director of the Year for his work in Irene in 1997.

From 1999 to 2002, Bruce joined up with Princess Cruise Lines as an Atrium Pianist, and was able to see much of the world in his travels. It was out on the high seas where Bruce developed and perfected his romantic piano playing in the style of John Tesh, with a little George Winston thrown in. In his leisure time, Bruce enjoys listening to a wide variety of music including Eva Cassidy, Amy Grant, Judy Collins, Manhattan Transfer, k.d. lang, Keiko Matsui, Zero 7, and even Lady Gaga!

He moved to Palm Springs in 2005 from Denver, CO, where he had accompanied the Denver Opera Company (now defunct). He currently serves as Music Director for Shepherd of the Valley United Methodist Church in Indio and was accompanist for the Palm Springs Gay Men's Chorus. From 2006 to 2010, he played piano for the Palm Springs Opera Guild's Outreach Program every June, during which he played piano for young opera stars who introduced opera to more than 3,500 kids each year within the Palm Springs Unified School District. In April 2008, Bruce serenaded the crowds at the Opera in the Park with prelude and Intermission music.

Performances in the Coachella Valley include: Little Shop of Horrors and You're A Good Man, Charlie Brown [2000], both at Palm Desert High School; Love's Embrace 2007 at his church in Indio; A Grand Night For Singing at the Joslyn Theatre (Palm Desert); 13 - a Teen Musical at IPAC in Indio; and was Music Director and Accompanist for It Had To Be You: A Musical Tribute to Betty Hutton in Palm Springs, May 2009.

Bruce released a CD of original songs and religious piano arrangements in October 2010, and soundbytes of this music may be heard on his website - www.brucemangum.com - as well as on iTunes.
